
PEDAGOGICAL CONDITION OF TEACHERS IN TECHNICAL HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS

The result of the questionnaire asking whether you are satisfied with the teaching method of the teachers who teach you in your specialty was as follows (Figure 1).

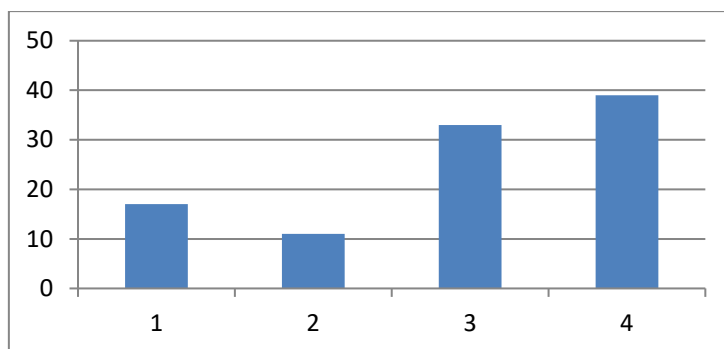

1- 17% deemed satisfactory by the student.

2- 11% considered unsatisfactory by the student.

3- 33% the student reported that the teaching method of the teacher was outdated.

4- 39% the student reported that it is satisfactory that only some teachers teach.
